Rabbits

The Babies have enjoyed spending lots of time outside exploring the different weathers.

They have especially enjoyed heading out in their puddle suits and splashing in the muddy puddles! We have spent time collecting the leaves, putting them into a big pile and kicking them around. At the beginning of the term we looked at fireworks and then danced around with ribbons to music. We have spent lots of time this last month getting ready for christmas. We practiced songs for the Christmas craft morning, we made a little surprise for all of our parents, enjoyed exploring different decorations and dressing up in our Christmas outfits.







Hedgehogs

It has been a very busy month in Hedgehog room. We have been exploring with gloop and finding out that it can appear to be both a solid and a liquid. We have been enjoying the outside by jumping in puddles, digging in the sand and filling buckets to make sandcastles!









The children have been demonstrating their developing control with their fine motor skills, carefully building tower with wooden blocks. They have been practising their large mark making movements when engrossed in the free painting activity at the table using paintbrushes and their hands too.

Foxes

Over the last few weeks, the children have been doing lots of different activities to do with shapes. We went on a shape hunt, we played with the 2D and 3D shapes making pictures and we made shape pictures by drawing around the shapes. We have done lots of activities about Autumn and the leaves falling off the trees including collecting leaves and making a picture with them. We have been implementing our new Pip and Pap Phonics Scheme, reading stories about Pip and Pap and the adventures they get up to on the farm. This has been helping us to develop our phonemic awareness.
